### PRESS RELEASE February 11, 2014

On Monday morning a Stamford woman was arrested by Delaware County Sheriff's Investigators and charged with a number of crimes following a heroin trafficking investigation.

Kelly M. Abbes, 40, also known as Kelly Zimmerman, was initially arrested and charged with Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a class B felony, and Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, a class E felony. Following a search of her residence by Sheriff's Investigators, Sheriff's K-9 "Ozzie" and Stamford Troopers, Abbes was also charged with Criminally Possessing a Hypodermic Instrument, a class A misdemeanor, and Unlawful Possession of Marihuana, a violation.

Abbes is accused of selling Heroin in the Village of Stamford earlier this year and then conspiring to obtain and sell additional Heroin last week.

Abbes was arraigned in the Town of Delhi Court and was ordered held in lieu of \$20,000 cash bail.

As a result of this investigation and arrest, Abbes was subsequently arrested on a warrant issued Monday afternoon by the New York State Division of Parole charging her with Violation of Parole.
