On Thursday afternoon members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division arrested two Village of Walton residents on felony drug charges.

On Thursday afternoon, members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office including K-9 "Ozzie", assisted by the Walton Police Department, executed a search warrant at 8 Benton Avenue, Walton, which led to the seizure of unlawfully possessed Suboxone and marihuana. Deputies subsequently arrested and charged the apartment's occupants, 32 year old Donald M. Debrock, and 21 year old Nicolette M. Fischetti, with the class D felony offense of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (*Intent to Sell*) and Unlawful Possession of Marihuana, a violation.

Delaware County Department of Social Services Child Protective Services was notified and responded to the scene to address the needs of two school aged children that reside within the residence.

Debrock and Fischetti were arraigned in the Walton Village Court before Village Justice Chad Hall Thursday evening and were each remanded to the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$75,000 cash bail pending further action in that court.

The search warrant was issued earlier this week by Acting Delaware County Court Judge Gary A. Rosa following a two month investigation conducted by members of the Delaware County

Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division into the unrelenting sales of illicit narcotics in the Village of Walton.

In part, this investigation focused on the sale of Suboxone and heroin by Donald M. Debrock during May and June of this year. Evidence developed during the course of that investigation was presented to a Delaware County Grand Jury on Thursday morning. A Sealed Indictment Arrest Warrant was subsequently issued Thursday afternoon by Delaware County Court Judge Richard D. Northrup, Jr., charging Debrock with two (2) class B felony counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree and one (1) class C felony charge of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree. Debrock was arrested on that arrest warrant and held in the Delaware County Correctional Facility pending arraignment in Delaware County Court Friday afternoon.

Debrock was arraigned in Delaware County Court on Friday afternoon before the County Court Judge Richard D. Northrup, Jr., and was ordered held without bail pending further court proceedings.

Speaking on the arrest, Undersheriff Craig DuMond remarked "The Delaware County Sheriff's Office is steadfast in our commitment toward making our communities a safe place to live, raise a family and conduct business. Our Investigators and Deputies will continue to be relentless in investigating and prosecuting these poisonous characters and placing them in state prison where they belong".
