

DEFENDANTS IN DRUG POSSESSION CASES FACE ADDITIONAL CHARGES.

On Tuesday morning four drug dealers were arrested and charged by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division in relation to narcotics sales that led to the execution of search warrants and drug possession arrests made by Deputies earlier this year.



Antonio J. Felice, 27, of Townsend Street, Walton, was charged Tuesday morning with three class "B" felony counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree. Felice is accused of selling heroin bundles and cocaine in the Village of Walton during late February and early March of this year.


As a result of those narcotics sales, members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division obtained and executed a search warrant at Felice' Townsend Street, Walton, residence on March 4, 2016. As a result of a search of the residence by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office, canine "Ozzie" and Walton Police Department, a number of individual glassine envelopes of heroin, baggies of "bulk" packaged heroin, prescription controlled substances, hypodermic instruments, marihuana and nearly \$500 cash was seized. At that time Felice was charged with one class B felony offense of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (*Heroin - intent to sell*) and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (*intent to sell*), a class D felony.

Felice is currently being held in the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$100,000 cash bail on the original charges and will be arraigned on the new charges in Delaware County Court at a later time.

Anna Christina Bubko, 20, of East Hubbell Hill Road, Margaretville, was charged Tuesday with four class "C" felony counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree and one class "B" felony count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in or near



School Grounds. Bubko is accused of selling Hydrocodone in the Town of Middletown during early March of this year, including the sale of Hydrocodone near the Margaretville Central School.



Lucas M. Labumbard, 25, of East Hubbell Hill Road, Margaretville, was also charged Tuesday with one class “C” felony counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree and one class “B” felony count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in or near School Grounds. Labumbard is also accused of selling Hydrocodone near the Margaretville Central School during early March of this year.


As a result of those narcotics sales, members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division obtained and executed a search warrant at Bubko and Labumbard's East Hubbell Hill Road, Margaretville, residence on March 14, 2016. As a result of a search of the residence by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office and New York State Police, Sheriff's Investigators seized quantities of Hydrocodone and Oxycodone tablets and more than \$1400 cash. Further investigation by Sheriff's Office and State Police Investigators at that time disclosed that Labumbard and Bubko were involved in the burglary of Miller's Drug Store on Main Street, Margaretville, between the night of February 1st and the morning of February 2nd and the theft of prescription narcotics including more than three thousand (3,000) Hydrocodone and Oxycodone tablets which they later sold and consumed. At that time Labumbard and Bubko were arrested by Sheriff's Investigators and charged with the class B felony offense of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (*intent to sell*), the class E felony of Tampering with Physical Evidence and a misdemeanor charge of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fifth Degree. They were also arrested by State Police Investigators and charged with the class D felony offense of Burglary in the Third Degree in relation to the Miller's Drug Store burglary and narcotics theft.

Labumbard is being held in the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$75,000 cash bail on the original charges and will be arraigned on the new charges in Delaware County Court at a later time.

Bubko is also being held in the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$50,000 cash bail on the original charges and will be arraigned on the new charges in Delaware County Court at a later time.

John J. Coe, 46, of Marvin Street, Deposit, was charged with three class “B” felony counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree. Coe is accused of selling bundles of heroin in the Village of Deposit during April of this year.

As a result of those narcotics sales, members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division obtained and executed



a search warrant at Coe's Marvin Street, Deposit, NY, residence on the morning of April 19 of this year.

A search of the apartment by Sheriff's Deputies, Investigators and K-9 "Ozzie" on the morning of April 19 led to the seizure of 205 bags of heroin, a number of Alprazolam (*Xanax*) tablets and \$200 U. S. Currency. Sheriff's Investigators subsequently arrested and charged Coe that day with the class B felony offense of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (*Heroin - possession with intent to sell*) and one class D felony charge of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree (*Alprazolam - possession with intent to sell*).

Coe is being held in the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$50,000 cash bail on the original charges and will be arraigned on the new charges in Delaware County Court at a later time.
