### PRESS RELEASE November 14, 2013

On Thursday evening a Bloomville mother and daughter, and a Syracuse man, were arrested on felony drug charges following an investigation conducted by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division.

Delaware County Sheriff's Investigators, Deputies and K-9 "Ozzie", assisted by the Chenango County Sheriff's Office K-9 Unit and members of the New York State Police Community Narcotics Enforcement Team executed a Search Warrant at the Tammy Fairbairn residence in the hamlet of Bloomville that led to the seizure of 130 bags of heroin, approximately \$1100 in cash and Public Assistance Benefit Cards.

Investigators arrested 46 year old Tammy Lee Fairbairn of Bloomville, 20 year old Nakota Lane of Bloomville and 26 year old Alamin McMillon of Syracuse, NY, and charged them with one count each of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a class B felony. They are accused of possessing heroin with the intent to sell and may face additional charges in the future.

The trio were arraigned before Town of Kortright Justice Yvonne Pagillo and were remanded to the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of bail. Fairbairn was ordered held in lieu of \$20,000 cash bail, Lane was held in lieu of \$20,000 cash bail and McMillon was held in lieu of \$30,000 cash bail.

The Delaware County Sheriff's Office is firmly dedicated in our efforts to identify, arrest and prosecute those responsible for trafficking drugs throughout Delaware County and will continue to collaborate and strengthen our partnerships with all our law enforcement counterparts in this endeavor.
