PRESS RELEASE

On Monday morning, Delaware County Sheriff's Office Investigators arrested a 29 year old Walton woman on felony charges following a joint investigation conducted by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division, Cooperstown Village Police Department and New York State Department of Health Bureau of Narcotics Enforcement, Syracuse, in cooperation with CVS Pharmacy.

Investigators arrested and charged Lisa M. Regg with one count of Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the Second Degree (*class D felony*) and one count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Fourth Degree (*class C felony*). Regg is accused of possessing and presenting a forged Official New York State Prescription form at the Walton CVS Pharmacy in February, 2013 and illegally obtaining and possessing a quantity of a narcotic preparation (*Hydrocodone*).

The forged prescription was reported to have been stolen from a care provider at Bassett Hospital in Cooperstown earlier this year. On April 11, 2013 Regg was arrested by the Cooperstown Police Department and charged with Petit Larceny in connection with the theft of the prescription form from Bassett Hospital.

Regg was also charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree (*class A misdemeanor*) after a search of her purse revealed that she was in possession of Vicodin tablets.

Regg was arraigned on the felony charges in the Delhi Town Court before the Honorable Richard Gumo and remanded to the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$3,000 cash bail pending a felony hearing scheduled for Friday. She was issued an Appearance Ticket returnable in the Town of Delhi Court to answer the charge of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree.
