On April 26th, 2014 the Delaware County Sheriff's Office, in conjunction with the United States Drug Enforcement Agency, participated in National Drug Take Back Day.

Numerous prescription drugs were taken in and safely removed from the residences and streets of Delaware County.

There will be another Take Back Day in the fall of this year. Dates are yet to be announced.

In the meantime, county residents are advised that they can drop off their unused and unwanted medications at the Delaware County Public Safety Building in the secured drop box in the main entrance anytime, day or night.

This drop box is for bottled prescription medications. It is not for needles and/or syringes. Information on where and how these items can be disposed of can be found at the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Drop box location.
