A Sidney man held in the Delaware County Correctional Facility since his arrest by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office and Village of Sidney Police Department last month was arrested by Delaware County Sheriff's Investigators on Wednesday afternoon, November 5, on a Sealed Grand Jury Indictment Warrant issued last week.

Richard T. Swislosky, 38, of Sidney, was arrested by Delaware County Sheriff's Office Investigators on October 8th and charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree and Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument in the First Degree concluding a month long investigation conducted by members of the Delaware County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division, the Village of Sidney Police Department and Delaware County Probation Department that focused on heroin trafficking in and around the Village of Sidney and City of Oneonta during September and October of this year.

Last week a Delaware County Grand Jury indicted Swislosky on those charges and two additional class B felony charges of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree in relation to his sales of heroin in the Sidney area prior to his October 8th arrest.

Swislosky was arraigned on the indictment in Delaware County Court by Acting County Court Judge John F. Lambert who remanded Swislosky to the Delaware County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$100,000 cash bail pending further court action.
