

PRESS RELEASE

On December 21, 2012, a 40 year old Town of Harpersfield man was arrested as a part of a continuing, joint investigation being conducted by the Delaware and Otsego County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Divisions and the United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) in cooperation with the New York State Police.

Delaware County Sheriff's Deputies arrested and charged Robert J. Wilsey with the class A-II felony offense of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Second Degree following the execution of a search warrant. Deputies anticipate Wilsey will face additional charges in the future.

Wilsey is accused of possessing over five ounces of Oxycodone powder, a narcotic drug, having an approximate street value of \$50,000.

Wilsey was arraigned in the Town of Stamford Court and remanded to the Delaware County Correctional Facility without bail.

Wilsey is expected to face additional charges and additional arrests are anticipated in the future.

Delaware and Otsego County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Divisions and the United States Drug Enforcement Administration continue to work with the Covidien Security Department in an attempt to identify sources of diverted pharmaceutical narcotics.
